of place to say I would, in all likelihood, be none of these today without God placing Walking Tall and its incredible people in my life. My mind wanders back to the conversations I had with so many great men and the lessons I learned from them; to the mealtime devotions that fed our souls so extensively (how the meals themselves were some of the best ever!); to how awesome evening worship was in fellowship with others.

Without this discovery, which I attribute wholly to God's grace and the people young and old at Walking Tall, I am confident I would not be teaching children the gospel as I do today through Child Evangelism Fellowship.

As a martial artist, I have learned how vital discipline and respect truly are from a young age. The mentors, Tom and Judy, taught me and reminded me to be respectful to others, to discipline myself to do hard things and do them well, to be filled with integrity and self-control, and to ask God for help often. There was a time when I wanted to stop martial arts on the verge of black belt, a five-year commitment, when training began to feel monotonous. At that major time in my life, my mom was the one who pushed me to continue on, and I have thanked her ever since, but the things I learned at Walking Tall, the biblical truths reinforced within me, setting my mind on things above, the practical fruits of the Spirit; those are what led me to be the martial artist I am today, and moreover the person I am today.

Lastly, as someone who hasn't seen their father in quite a long time, I recognize the importance of a father figure in one's life. I may not have seen it then, but looking back, I needed those men in my life. Yet another reason I thank God for Walking Tall.
