No matter how bad things may seem, there is always hope. Whatever the problems may be, change is possible if people want it and are willing to work at it.

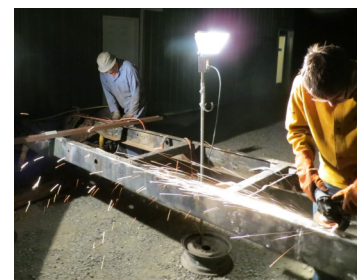
Hope is just one of the tools offered at Walking Tall.
