Peter is now at the Walking Tall age, and when he comes to visit, he enjoys being a part of the Walking Tall events. Peter built his very own little side table. He has learned the tools and the safety

behind these tools, just as all the other young men know. The mentors and young men who knew these boys before Jackson's accident are welcoming during their visits, and when they tell their parents they have been praying for them, it is encouraging and shows the love this WT family has to offer.
