Being motivated and driven keeps him at a high standard to get good grades, and he also achieved the high honor of earning his Eagle Scout rank a couple of years ago. Logan enjoys cars, and when he first came to WT, he didn't have any knowledge about the automotive industry. He has learned many practical skills now, especially in the automotive field.

Logan says, "I want to work on my faith more; coming to Walking Tall is my only chance to hear Scripture because of my work schedule lately. WT helps keep me grounded. It reminds me to keep a standard for myself, about how I approach people and act around friends. I'm not perfect, but this group encourages me to reflect on my speech and actions."
