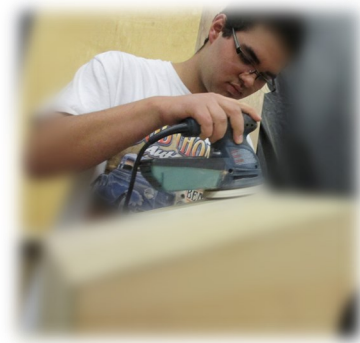
Mission Driven

Walking Tall has been a significant part of my life since I was 14 years old. Initially, I started in the welding shop, then worked on the bus for about a year. After that, I moved to the woodshop where I crafted the Cajon drum boxes. At the age of 18, I left for missionary work, traveling to 37 states, and organizing daily retreats in middle and high schools. When I returned, I had lunch with Tom, and we discussed the Redwood business. Soon after, I started working there. I remained actively involved in the ministry of Walking Tall by conducting interviews on Monday and Wednesday nights for Judy's weekly updates.

During my mission work travels, I met my best friend who I started dating a year ago. Because of the long distance, we could only see each other every couple of months. However, in September I moved to Michigan and now live only 20 minutes away from her. I share a house with a couple of guys I met on the mission field, and we have established some rules to make our house a place of accountability and prayer. This is a big change from having to take a six-hour plane flight to visit her. I am also taking a two-year ministry course to equip me with better skills.

During my mission journey, I realized I talked about Walking Tall daily. It became a significant part of my testimony that I shared with others. As I move on, Walking Tall will continue to be a part of my story, and I am grateful for the time I had to share it with others and teach them the skills that I have. Perhaps, I could even start another Walking Tall out here.
