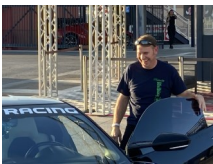
WHAT DID THE SEMA TRIP MEAN TO YOU?



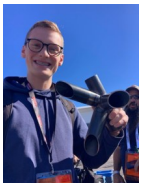

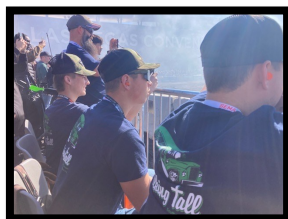

our time together and trust Him to bring us home safely. *Dan*

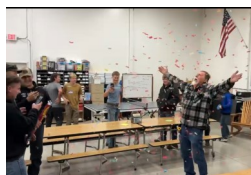
