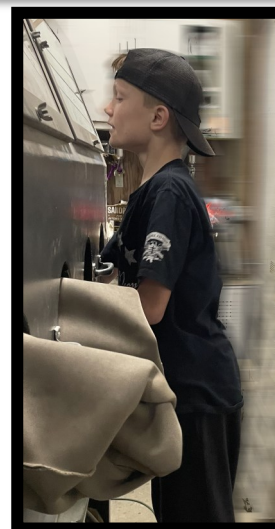
## Reliable Skills

Jeremy shares that he has gained a better connection with God since coming to Walking Tall and knows what He did for us.

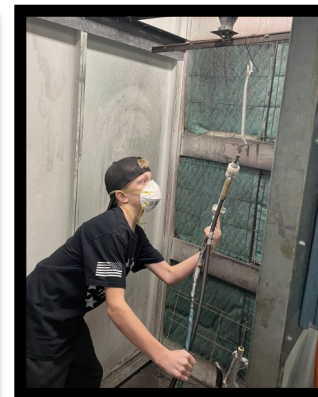
