## Engaging God's Word

Mentors from Walking Tall are preparing to launch a new Bible study for young men, with interest already shown by several participants. This initial phase is helping prepare the mentors, who are focused on improving their ability to answer questions and communicate the gospel effectively. They emphasize the importance of aligning their words with their actions. Every young man reacts differently to guidance and comes from various backgrounds. They face specific challenges where mentors will be understanding and sensitive to their spirit, especially the younger ones who are learning self-control.



Even when they are struggling, we should meet them where they are, offering encouragement to help them grow. Two of our mentors have formed a strong relationship through past Bible studies. One excels at sharing information but struggles with one-on-one conversations, while the other connects well with young men by making concepts relatable. Together, they complement each other's strengths and weaknesses as teachers.

Our goal is to empower both young and older mentors to engage young men with biblical principles that resonate with their experiences. The mentors believe that learning together is valuable because it aligns their understanding as they work in different areas.

This collaboration enables them to apply Bible study teachings effectively with young men and helps develop them into good leaders who represent Christ well. Ultimately, this effort benefits everyone involved, and inspires one another through compassion and love.
