Positive Memories

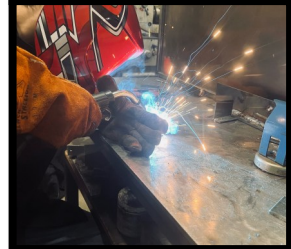
